ANZCCJ currently has approximately 550 members. The membership consists of Australian and New Zealand members conducting business in Japan, Japanese companies with economic ties to Australia and New Zealand, overseas members and others maintaining business relationships between Japan and Australia/New Zealand.

ANZCCJ's mission is to play a constructive and meaningful role in developing Australia/New Zealand-Japan business by providing Members with an effective source of information, representation and commercial connections.

ANZCCJ's internship program provides hands-on work experience to young Australian, New Zealand and Japanese students and graduates. Through this programme, ANZCCJ aims to:

- Contribute to building a Japan-literate workforce in Australia and New Zealand; and
- Help ensure younger generations of Aussies and Kiwis remain involved and interested in Japan, and build interest in Australia and New Zealand among the younger Japanese generation.

To date, over 50 interns have participated our internship program since its start in 2017. Since mid-2020, the program has offered both remote and hybrid internships, opening opportunities to students and graduates based outside of Japan.





Young Generation Programme (YGP)

The ANZCCJ Young Generation Program aims to bring together and foster new connections among the next generation of leaders in the Australia, New Zealand and Japan business community, to share information, career advice, networking and professional development. The program was established in May 2021, as an updated version of the former Youth Empowerment Program.


